DECEMBER MEETING: Seventy-two members and their guests attended the December 4 meeting. The usual display of horological items generated buying, selling, and trading, and fellowship and camaraderie among the clock and watch collectors.

PUBLIC PROJECT: Tom Spittler and Earl Harlamert promoted horological education within the area communities. They presented their program on the history of Luman Watson clocks at several venues during 2016. The Chapter thanks them for their commitment to sharing their knowledge and enthusiasm for horology.

DECEMBER PROGRAM: Bob Fink gave a presentation on **tandem wind clocks**, a design in which a single arbor is used to wind the time and the strike. The arbor is turned one direction to wind the time and the opposite direction to wind the strike. Harvard Clock Co., Boston Clock Co., Eastman, and others made a single-wind system for time-and-strike clocks. Bob showed several rare examples and various movements from his collection.
